

Regulations of the IX Annual International Scientific and Practical Conference «SCIENTIA UNESCAMUS», 19-21 March, 2020, Moscow, Russia

1. General provisions

Scientific and Practical Conference «SCIENTIA UNESCAMUS» (hereinafter referred to as Conference) is a comprehensive program of supporting talented children and youth, a form of cooperation between educational institutions, students, teachers, academics and scientists from different regions of Russia and all over the World. It is held once a year. The conference objective is to support and promote talented children and youth, to attract public attention to the problems of society intellectual potential development. The organizing and holding of the conference is realized by the High School №1517 and Moscow Department of education and science. The leadership of the conference is conducted by the scientific student community of the High School №1517. Special Expert Committee including specialists in different areas is responsible to estimate student works.

2. The order of participation in the conference

The conference is held in 3 stages:

The 1st stage is a full-time scientific and theoretical tour. The conference is an open event, so everyone may attend it as an audience. Scientists and specialists of various areas of knowledge and authors of different works are invited to the conference by organizers to make a speech.

The 2nd stage is a correspondence tour of the contest. All the students' works are required to be sent before the 1st of February, 2020. This stage deals with examination and estimating students' works presented for the contest. Please apply for accommodation program before 10th of February, 2020.

The 3^{rd} stage is a full-time scientific and practical tour. The participation in the 3^{rd} stage depends on the results of the 2^{nd} stage. Those who will pass through the 2^{nd} tour will be invited to take part in the contest on the 19^{th} of March, 2020

Participants of the competition are students of 5-11 grades. Essays and descriptive papers cannot be placed for consideration. 3. Closing remarks

The results of the second stage of the competition will be summed up before the 1st of March, 2020, by the Expert Committee.

All papers will get marks and estimates from the experts. The results (points) of the first and second stages of the conference will be summarized. The authors of winner papers and their project managers will be invited for the full-time (the 3rd stage) tour. The program of full-time tour (the 3rd stage) provides project defence in oral and stand forms.

The winners of the research and project works competition will be awarded prizes, diplomas, certificates and presents.

The following certain nominations are established on the competition:

- for the best interdisciplinary project
- for the most actual idea of the project
- for the best design of stand
- for the most original problem solution
- for the most large-scale study
- and other nominations

Interested organizations and Partners of the Conference can establish their own nominations and carry out awarding in these nominations.

These organizations should coordinate with the organizers of the conference. Winners of the Conference obtain additional benefits on admitting Partner-Universities of the Conference according to Rules of the University.

The most interesting projects will be published in scientific-popular almanac "Higgs' Boson"

The results of the conference will be published in printed matters and electronic mass media.
